They will also develop their leadership skills and participate in team building games and challenges.

Reading Circles

Part of our reading programme is “Reading Circles” – in groups the students read the same story, taking it in turns to read sentences, paragraphs or the whole page whilst thinking about the story and connecting to the text. Each person takes it in turn to be the Summariser, Predictor, Clarifier and the Questioner.

- **Summariser** shares what the text was about
- **Predictor** predicts what might happen and justify their predictions
- **Questioner** asks a question about the text
- **Clarifier** identifies tricky or interesting words and what they mean
